Director of Advancement

Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively and creatively with various Regis College constituents to appropriately and strategically position advancement opportunities for major gifts, endowment campaigns, planned giving, and cultivating new and existing donor relationships.
- Create and sustain a vibrant alumni/ae culture and relations in Toronto and elsewhere.
- Plan, manage and successfully execute a major capital campaign.
- Co-ordinate the 2020 Regis College 90th year celebration with fundraising.
- Demonstrate high proficiency and experience in writing grant submissions, various reports, promotional materials, donor correspondence and appeal communication
- Manage prospect research with a focus on pursuing strategies to secure or increase giving from donors.
- Demonstrate leadership in organizing and implementing key fundraising events for the College.
- Receive, process and receipt donations for proper recordkeeping and financial reporting.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree or higher preferably in marketing, fundraising, or communications.
- Minimum of 3-5 years' experience in not-for-profit fundraising with a demonstrated track record of success in capital campaigns, raising major gifts and executing key fundraising initiatives.
- An appreciation and understanding of the Society of Jesus, its theology and spirituality in order to articulate its mission and values to internal and external audiences.
- Working knowledge and familiarity with advancement best practices, fundraising tools and technology, including donor databases, e-mail and online campaigns and research.
- Demonstrate strategic, problem solving, creative thinking and decision-making skills.
- Strong verbal communication skills, initiative and the ability to multi-task.
- Excellent writing skills, including the ability to produce high quality prose quickly and under deadlines.
- A professional with a spirit of teamwork and a positive attitude.
- Ability to develop fundraising budgets and prepare financial reports.
- Excellent computer skills including proficiency in Microsoft Word and Excel as well as various graphic design software programs.
- Some knowledge of French is preferred.
- Some travel maybe required.
