Part-time Library Technician One year contract (with possible extension)

Hours: 16 hours/week

Responsibilities:

User Services

Staff the circulation desk and provide assistance to patrons Assist patrons with use of library equipment (Computers, scanner, etc.)

Collection Management

Receiving – order receiving, invoice reconciliations and vendor management, claims and returns

Serials Management – serials check-in, claims, invoice processing and recordkeeping/statistics

Other/occasional - Assist with the evaluation of donated items, shelving, shifting, preparing and co-ordinating binding shipments and repair.

Qualifications

- Library Techniques Diploma or equivalent.
- Relevant experience in an academic library
- Reading knowledge French is desirable
- Experience using library management systems and standard office applications
- Excellent interpersonal relations, organization and communications skills.
