The incumbent will prepare content for children to support Christian and multi-faith formation with a focus on social justice issues and values for in-person delivery and online delivery. Content and resources will support spiritual growth and curiosity among children in a Christian and multi-faith context. The incumbent will provide leadership for children's programming through storytelling, videos, multimedia, and other means of communication. The incumbent will also design activity packages and resources for distribution to support faith formation, and work on other tasks as required by the organization.

- Dialogue with local multi-faith community partners to create synergies and joint programming
- Coordinating access to existing pastoral care and other resources as needed
- Communicating with parents and volunteers as needed
- Collaborating with staff, congregants and volunteers
- Other tasks, as required
