#### **DISTRIBUTION**

The amount of the award will be credited to your student account on ACORN. The College reserves the right to withhold awards if a student's financial account is in arrears. Before the amount is credited to student accounts, students must input their Social Insurance Number (S.I.N.) on ACORN.

Scholarships/bursaries granted to D.Min. students will be applied to student's fees in two equal installments (in the Summer term and September term). For all other students, the amount will be applied to the student's fees in two equal installments (in the September term and January term).

## **APPLICATION DEADLINES**

March 15 Last day for current students.

August 15 Last day for incoming new students.

November 15 Last day for incoming January students and for current students for undistributed funds.

Applications must be received by the end of business day in the Registrar's Office. Late applications will not be considered until the next round based on available funds.

- Full tuition support is available for full-time studies (value up to \$7,200 per year) for up to three years with satisfactory progress toward degree.

- Students pursuing part-time studies may apply for limited, partial tuition support.
- Students remain responsible for extended health and other non-tuition fees.
- Applicants are normally Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, or Conventional Refugees.
- Successful applicants agree to contribute three hours of service per week at the College, a church, or a service agency during the academic term.
- Students from Indigenous and diverse cultural backgrounds are especially encouraged to apply.
